The vessel also includes a custom Wyland-inspired cabin including custom marine grade upholstery, wood accents and is appointed with a Wyland back-lit acrylic design. The Wyland 26 Super Sport features dolphins as the centerpiece of this go-fast center console. The boat design features dolphins moving majestically on the hull. Each boat is designed to accommodate all boating lifestyles and transitions into a boat suitable for diving and fishing. A portion of proceeds from the two Wyland limited edition 2009 boats will benefit the continuing education outreach of the Wyland Foundation. Wyland has taken even broader steps toward that goal recently with the completion of his epic 27-year long global Whaling Wall project. In July, as an official artist for the U.S. Olympic team, he completed his final mural, a 3,200 meter series of canvases in the heart of Beijing for the 2008 Olympics Cultural Festival, with the help of children from 110 countries. The project received tremendous fanfare later in the month when a portion of it was unveiled for US Olympics sponsors and President Bush. Recognized by the United Nations for his environmental outreach, the art of Wyland, including the artist’s murals, is seen by nearly one billion people around the world. He has appeared on television’s Discovery Channel and currently hosts his own art instruction show on PBS. Like all of his work, Wyland’s goal through his company and through his non-profit Wyland Foundation is to inspire people to a greater awareness of our ocean planet, from its ocean to its lakes, rivers, streams and waterways. Through his art and outreach, he has led the charge to promote conservation of water resources through classroom education programs, community events, and art in public places.
